

## 02 Time Frames for Requesting Verification - Overview

**REVISION 02**  
(10/01/07 - 12/31/07)

Give the PI ten calendar days to provide the requested information or verification using the procedures outlined in [information verification](#). The ten day period starts the day after the date of the interview.

When the ten day period ends on a weekend or holiday, the due date is the following work day.

### **WARNING**

Allow ten calendar days to provide information even when it delays the eligibility determination past the application processing time frames. (See [Delays in the Eligibility Determination](#))

### **MA EXCEPTION**

Give the participant 20 days to provide verification of [qualified noncitizen](#) and [citizenship](#) status. When the 20 day period ends on a weekend or holiday, the due date is the following work day.
