

.01 CA PRA Sanction Notification

When a participant does not comply with a PRA requirement, a sanction is imposed.

Noncompliance notification occurs in one of the following ways:

- FAA receives a Sanctions: Noncompliance/Compliance Request e-mail from DCSS. FAA issues the [NOAA](#) to the noncompliant participant and imposes the sanction. (See [Sanction Notices](#))
- FAA receives an ACTS alert generated by Jobs to impose a Jobs sanction. Jobs issues the NOAA to the noncompliant participant.
- The [CA DEAUTH - PROG SANC ACTS](#) alert is generated monthly by AZTECS when rollover occurs and a budgetary unit has an ongoing sanction. (See [Imposing Ongoing CA Sanction](#))
