A HP Automatic Referrals

AZTECS generates an automatic referral for HP to AHCCCS when the parent or stepparent meets ALL of the following eligibility factors:

- Is <u>willing to pay</u> a <u>premium(g)</u> for AHCCCS Health Insurance.
 (See AHCCCS Premium Amounts)
- Has their own dependent child or stepchild, UNDER 18, eligible in the <u>S.O.B.R.A. Child(g)</u> (SC) category, living in the home.
- Meets <u>citizenship</u> or <u>qualified noncitizen</u> requirements.
- Is denied Title XIX MA because their income exceeds the HP maximum income limit or resource limit on MADA using the EI (Excess Income), IM (excess Income MD) or RE (Resources Exceed limit; for MD only) Denial or Closure Reason Codes.
- Meets SSN requirements.
- Meets Arizona residency requirements.
- Does not have <u>TPL creditable insurance</u>.

NOTE TPL information MUST be verified and keyed on HEID for all applicants who have health insurance coverage other than AHCCS.

- Is not a state employee(g) or the spouse of a state employee.
- GROSS income of the budgetary unit is equal to or below 200% of the current FPL.
- Did not voluntarily stop health insurance in the past three months. (See <u>Three Month Bare</u> Period)
- Is found eligible when the program is available.

AHCCCS sends the approval notice for the parent or stepparent when the referral meets all eligibility factors. The approval notice includes the months approved for the parent or stepparent.

WARNING

Eligibility for this Title XXI program DOES NOT go back to the first day of the month of application. Eligibility starts NO EARLIER than the first day of the month following the month of application. This is referred to as prospective eligibility.
