

D Verification Documents for MA Identity

Acceptable identity documents (current or expired) used with a MA citizenship document to prove U.S. citizenship include any of the following:

- A state photo drivers license.
- A school issued photo ID card.
- A Social Security Number verified through the WTPY process.
- Eligibility in the Deemed Newborn MA category through the [CR600 process](#), when there has been no break in AHCCCS coverage.
- U.S. Military ID card (active, reserve, and retired).
- U.S. Military draft record.
- U.S. Military dependent ID card.
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card.
- Clinic, doctor, shot, or hospital record (under age 16 only).
- School record or report card (Under age 16 only).
- Daycare or nursery school record (under age 16 only).
- Native American tribal documents.
- Court documents for children in foster care.
- ID card issued by federal, state, or local government agencies. When the ID card does not contain a photo, identifying information must be included on the ID card. Identifying information includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Name
 - Address
 - Sex
 - Date of birth or age
 - Height
 - Hair color
 - Eye color

- The Affidavit Attesting Identity (DE-178) form may be used for children under 16 and incapacitated adults.

NOTE The adult's incapacity must be verified. (See [Incapacitated Applicant](#))
