

.04 Victim of Severe Trafficking

A victim of severe human trafficking is admitted into the U.S. under the Trafficking Victims Protection Act (TVPA) of 2000.

This noncitizen is potentially eligible for benefits for a period of seven years from the date that their status is granted.

MA EXCEPTION

The seven year period does not apply. There is no maximum time limit.

Applicants are potentially eligible for benefits regardless of any later change in their status. (See [LPR Eligibility](#))

These applicants will have one of the following USCIS documents:

- [I-94](#) with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
- Passport, with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
- I-797, Notice of Action, with a T visa or Derivative T visa (T, T-2, T-3, T-4, or T-5).
