

C Federal Emergency Services (FES) Referrals

AHCCCS determines Federal Emergency Services (FES) eligibility for applicants who meet any of the following:

- Age 65 and over
- Under age 65, and any of the following:
 - Blind
 - Diagnosed with End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD)
 - Disabled (See [FES Referrals- Blind or Disabled](#))
 - Receiving dialysis
 - Acute leukemia

NOTE AHCCCS has a streamlined application process for FES applicants with ESRD, kidney failure, or acute leukemia.

Complete the Emergency Service Referrals to AHCCCS Screening Guide (FAA-1213A), to determine when referrals are needed, when either of the following apply:

- An applicant is age 65 and over. (See [FES over 65](#))
- An applicant is under 65 and meets any of the following:
 - Blind
 - Diagnosed with ESRD
 - Disabled (See [FES Disabled](#))
 - Receiving dialysis
 - Acute leukemia
