

.08 Scheduling Medical Appointments

Medical appointments can be made to establish eligibility under the disability criteria for either local office or [DMC determinations](#). Complete the following:

- Arrange a medical appointment for a participant claiming disability when the medical information available is not enough to establish disability.
- Designated staff make the appointment with an appropriate doctor in the project area. Check with the supervisor for a list of appropriate doctors in the area.
- Send or give an Authorization for Medical Examination (FA-194) form to the PI. Send a copy of the FA-194 to the scheduled doctor. Inform the PI that failure to appear for the medical appointment can result in denial or closure of CA benefits.
- A participant who is certified disabled for deprivation purposes, must accept medical treatment for which they are referred by the DMC. When the participant refuses treatment, deny the CA application or close the CA case in accordance with the correct [decision notice time frames](#).
