

D Resources Disqualification Period - NA

The disqualification period for participants applying for benefits begins the month of application.

The disqualification period for participants receiving NA begins with the first benefits issued after the [NOAA](#) has expired, unless the participant has requested an Appeal and continued benefits. Complete the following:

- Determine the amount in excess of the resource limit. Add the value of the transferred resource to other countable resources, and subtract the total from the maximum [NA resource limit](#).
- Determine the disqualification period from the following:

Amount in Excess of the NA Resource Limit	Period of Disqualification
0 to 249.99	1 month
250 to 999.99	3 months
1,000 to 2,999.99	6 months
3,000 to 4,999.99	9 months
5,000 to more	12 months

- Send the [F200 notice](#) on NORE explaining the reason for the disqualification and the length of the disqualification period.

NOTE The disqualification period is not keyed in [AZTECS](#). Document the [case file\(g\)](#) thoroughly to ensure the disqualification period is enforced.
