

D Categorical Eligibility Application Calculation

AZTECS does not compare the income of a categorically eligible FS budgetary unit against the [Gross](#) and [Net](#) Income Standards. However, benefits are calculated based on [FS income criteria](#). Consider the following:

- When the budgetary unit is categorically eligible for FS benefits, follow normal processing procedures.
- All FS categorically eligible one and two-person budgetary units are eligible for at least \$10.

FS EXCEPTION

FS categorically eligible one and two-person budgetary units are NOT eligible for at least \$10 when the allotment is reduced to less than \$10 as a result of [FS proration](#). (See [Eligible No Pay Special Keying Procedures](#))

- Place a budgetary unit in an eligible no pay status when they do not receive benefits for one of the following reasons:

Budgetary units whose benefits are reduced to less than \$10 as a result of [FS proration](#).

Budgetary units with three or more participants who are eligible for zero benefits. (See [Eligible-No Pay Special Keying Procedures](#))
