04 Food Stamp Categorical Eligibility - Overview

Consider a budgetary unit categorically eligible to receive FS when any of the following apply:

 ONE or MORE participants receive, or are authorized to receive <u>TANF benefits or services(g)</u> and the entire FS budgetary unit benefits from them. This applies even when one of the following occurs:

The CA benefit is less than \$10.

Benefits are being recouped and no payment is made.

(See Examples CE TANF 1-7)

 ALL participants in a budgetary unit receive, or are authorized to receive, GA or SSI or a combination of these benefits.

NOTE Disabled participants receive <u>special considerations</u> when budgeting and determining eligibility for FS.

This includes participants whose SSI benefits are in <u>no-pay(g)</u> or <u>suspend status(g)</u>.

(See Example CE GA or SSI 1 and Example CE GA or SSI 2)

Applicants who apply for SSI and FS before their release from an institution are not categorically eligible until both of the following occur:

- Their SSI is approved.
- They are released from the institution. The effective date of the application is the date of release.

EXCEPTION

This does not include SSI participants who meet one of the following:

Payments are suspended for failure to comply with a drug or alcohol treatment requirement.

Ineligible for SSI and considered in SSI non-pay status.

(See Exceptions to FS Categorical Eligibility)

Consider an FS categorically eligible budgetary unit to have met the following FS Eligibility Factors:

- Resources.
- Gross and net income tests.
- Sponsored noncitizen information.
- Residency.
- <u>Social Security numbers</u> for CA and GA participants, and SSI recipients.

(See Food Stamp Categorical Special Keying Procedures)

A budgetary unit remains categorically eligible for FS when one or more participants in the budgetary unit are not participating because of one of the following reasons:

- The participant is a <u>nonqualified noncitizen</u> or verification to resolve questionable citizenship is pending.
- The participant is <u>institutionalized</u> in a nonexempt facility.
- The participant is disqualified from CA or SSI for failure to provide or apply for an SSN.
