

**.06 NA Overpayment Compromise – Compromise Determination -
Compromise Household Groups**

There are two compromise household groups used to determine the NA compromise. The groups are as follows:

- Group 1 is when the only source of countable income is [Social Security Benefits](#) benefit, [TANF](#) or any combination of Social Security Benefits or TANF.

When these are the only sources of income, the expenses section of the NUTRITION ASSISTANCE COMPROMISE REQUEST FOR INCOME/EXPENSES STATEMENT does not have to be completed.

The person who requested the compromise can sign and return the NUTRITION ASSISTANCE COMPROMISE REQUEST FOR INCOME/EXPENSES STATEMENT with verification of income when previous verification has not been provided.

When the compromise household is identified as Group 1 the person responsible to pay the overpayment qualifies to have the full remaining balance of the NA overpayment compromised. No further verification is required. The OFFER OF COMPROMISE AGREEMENT is sent.

- Group 2 is when the source(s) of income is as follows:

[Self-Employment Income\(g\)](#)

[Unearned income\(g\)](#) from sources other than Group 1

A combination of Group 1 AND Group 2 income
