

.01 TPEP Benefit Extensions – Extension Requirements

Pascua Yaqui Tribal TANF Program budgetary units are eligible to receive a six-month TPEP benefit extension when they remain TANF eligible, and meet ONE of the following requirements:

- A parent is enrolled in a vocational educational training program that meets both of the following:
The program has been approved by the Native Employment Works (NEW) case manager.
The program will be completed within the six-month extension period.
- A parent is in a NEW unpaid work experience activity and the parent is expected to be hired within the six-month extension period.

When found eligible, the Pascua Yaqui Tribal TANF Program TPEP budgetary unit receives benefits as follows:

- Six months of TPEP benefits within a 12-month period immediately followed by a six-month TPEP extension period.
- Six months of TPEP benefits following the six-month TPEP extension period.

NOTE A second six-month TPEP extension period is allowed only when there is a break in benefits after the first TPEP extension period.
